Learning Outcomes:

- Upon completion of required readings and assignments, students will be able to describe the structure of the federal court system and at least one state court system, as well as the method for enacting and promulgating the laws and rules that those courts enforce.
- From participation in class discussions and small group assignments, students will learn to evaluate the pros and cons associated with at least 3 different business organizations and develop the documents required to bring at least one such entity into being.

- Through recorded lecture and synchronous online class discussion, students will learn to explain and apply the 3 basic standards of proof courts employ in testing the constitutionality of government actions.
- Upon completion of required readings, viewing of lecture materials and participation in synchronous online class discussions, students will be able to describe all elements that comprise select causes of action in areas of tort, property and contract law.
- Upon completion of all class requirements, students will be able to identify potential legal issues in unfamiliar fact patterns and correctly predict outcomes of hypothetical court cases.
