

Student Access Instructions Learning Catalytics in Mastering & Modified Mastering

Your instructor will let you know if your class is using Learning Catalytics with Mastering.

Enter Your Mastering Course:

Click Learning Catalytics from your Mastering
 Course Home page on a computer to establish your
 Learning Catalytics connection and determine whether
 you already have a subscription to Learning Catalytics
 or need to purchase access.



- 2. If you purchased Mastering without eText, you are prompted to purchase access to Learning Catalytics. If you purchased Mastering with eText, you can access Learning Catalytics right away from your Mastering course.
 - You get Learning Catalytics access at no charge with the eText for your Mastering course. Students who purchase or receive the specific eText or eText 2.0 edition associated with their course gain a subscription to Learning Catalytics. The subscription duration may be for either 18 months (for most textbooks) or 24 months (for eTexts that are typically used over two semesters).
 - If you need to purchase a subscription to Learning Catalytics because you are
 using Mastering without eText, you will see the option to purchase access for 6
 or 12 months after you click Learning Catalytics from within your course.
